For children to uphold the values of Vasse Soccer Club; Fairness, Participation, Discipline and Fun they must be safe and confident to report concerns. This aligns to Vasse Soccer Club Safeguarding Policy.

Our commitment to Safeguarding children at our club aims to provide ;

- A safe culture that empowers children to voice concerns if they feel unsafe;
- A culture of education about safeguarding; so, all parents and coaches are aware of the club safeguarding practises and know the process to support children if they feel unsafe
- An environment that supports the policy and procedures of Safeguarding from our governing bodies, including Football West and Football Australia; and
- At the Vasse Soccer Club we commit to embedding our Safeguarding Framework across all people including; parents, players, coaches and spectators, all environments; home and away games, academies and selected teams; and events; games, training and social events.

We commit to delivering an environment Children and Young People, can express and communicate their concerns. This includes those from diverse backgrounds including our First Nations Children and Young People, those living with disability, those from culturally and linguistically diverse communities and those who identify as LGBTIQ+.
